Tips on Showing:

- A. Please read the tips on showing as well as the Rules and Regulations and follow all instructions carefully.
- B. All entries must be in the Maynard Building, **in place and set up by 4:00 pm** on Friday, October 6.
- C. All entries must be in heavy containers; glass jars, bottles or pottery containers that will not spill. Plastic cups, plastic bottles and paper cups will not be accepted. **Please make sure your name is on the bottom of all your containers.**
- D. All potted houseplants must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least three months and in **pots 8" or under**. Your name must be on the bottom of the pot.
- E. Please Note: **Entry tags must be firmly attached to all articles by the exhibitor and ready to display when brought into the building. Articles without tags or with tags improperly filled out will not be accepted!**
- F. All entries must be picked up in person at the Maynard Building on Monday, October 9 beginning **NO EARLIER THAN 6:00 pm**. We cannot be responsible for items not picked up on Monday.
- G. Unless otherwise stated the prize money for Class 62 is as follows;
1st - \$6.00 / 2nd - \$5.00 / 3rd - \$4.00

CLASS 62A: House Plants (home grown)

Sections

1. Cactus
2. Succulent
3. Plant grown for foliage
4. Plant in flower
5. African Violet – any variety

CLASS 62B: Annuals (planted every year)

Sections

6. Marigold, any variety – 3 stems or blooms
7. Coleus, any variety – 3 stems

8. Snapdragons – 3 stems
9. Begonias – 3 stems or sprays
10. Geraniums, with foliage – 1 to 3 stems
11. Blue Salvia – 3 stems
12. Dahlia – 1 to 3 stems
13. 3 stems or sprays of any other annual not listed above. Please name.

CLASS 62C: Perennials (a plant that comes up every year)

Sections

14. Phlox – 1 to 3 stems

15. Sedum – 1 to 3 stems
16. A Fruited/Berried Branch
17. Coneflower, any colour – 1 to 3 stems (daisy like flower i.e., Black-eyed Susan)
18. Hosta, any variety – 3 leaves
19. 1 to 3 stems of any other Perennial not listed above. Please name.
20. Grasses, in bloom – 3 stems

CLASS 62D: Roses

Sections

21. Any variety – 1 to 3 stems
