Tips on Showing:

- A. Read and follow all the instructions carefully.
- B. All entries must be the exclusive and personal work of the person submitting the entry.
- C. This is a competition for amateur artists and the work of professional's will not be accepted.
- D. An entry fee of \$5.00 must be included with your entry for Classes 63A and 63C. There is no entry fee required for Class 63B or 64.
- E. Exhibitors will only be allowed one entry per section.
- F. All entries in Class 63 must be framed and wired for hanging. Sketches are to be mounted on a hard-backed paper, extending 1 ½" to 2" outside the sketch. The artist's name must be visible on the back of the work.
- G. **All entries must be received in the Secretary's Office by 4:00 pm on Thursday, October 5, 2022.**
- H. Entry tags must be firmly attached to all articles by the exhibitor. Articles without tags or with tags improperly filled out will not be accepted!
- I. The judge reserves the right not to show entries which they consider not suitable for family viewing.
- J. Exhibits must not have been entered in previous Woodbridge Fairs.
- K. All entries must be picked up in person at the COATES ARTS & CRAFTS BUILDING on Monday, October 9 beginning **NO EARLIER THAN 6:00 pm**, when the building closes.

CLASS 63A: ADULT DIVISION - open to entrants aged 18 and older.

Prize Money for 63A:

1st - \$10.00 / 2nd - \$8.00 / 3rd - \$5.00

Sections

1. A Scene with Fall Colours – any medium
2. A Still Life, harvest theme – any medium
3. An Abstract – any medium
4. Landscape – any medium
5. Portrait in charcoal, pencil or colour pencil drawing
6. A scene using at least 90% natural materials (leaves, twigs etc.)

7. Subject of your choice, using recycled materials

CLASS 63B: YOUTH DIVISION – open to ages 10 to 17.

Prize Money for 63B:

1st - \$8.00 / 2nd - \$5.00 / 3rd - \$3.00

Sections

1. A Scene with Fall Colours – watercolour or acrylic
2. A Nature Scene using natural materials (leaves, twigs etc.)
3. A scene of the Fall Fair using recycled materials
4. A portrait using pencil or colour pencil

CLASS 63C: SENIOR DIVISION – open to age 65 and older.

Prize Money for 63C:

1st - \$10.00 / 2nd - \$8.00 / 3rd - \$5.00

Sections

1. A Special place – watercolour
2. A Still Life, Fall harvest theme – any medium
3. A Scene with Fall Colours – oil or acrylic

Prize Money: 1st - \$15.00 / 2nd - \$10.00 / 3rd - \$8.00

Please Note: entries in this class can be made by the student or by a schoolteacher on their behalf.

- The hand drawn poster must clearly show the name, dates, and theme of the fair.
- Poster Size:
 - Minimum 22cm x 28cm without border
 - Maximum 28cm x 44cm without border
- Entries must be centered on a cardstock or Bristol board backing exposing a 5.5 cm border on all four sides.
- The 1st place poster becomes the property of the Woodbridge Fair Board and may be used in the Fair's promotional advertising
- The winning poster will be eligible to enter the district competition. The district winner will be eligible for the provincial competition.
- For district competition the name of fair, district (#5), contact person, owner of poster to be clearly labeled on the back.

Judging Standards:

- Overall Appearance – 50 points
 - Fair name, dates & theme clear
- Creativity & Design – 35 points
 - Attracts and holds attention
- OAAS Criteria – 15 points
 - Size, material, theme
