Tips on Showing:

- A. Read the Prize List and follow the instructions carefully.
- B. Class 80 is open to Grades JK to 3 (grade as of September 2022) in schools in Vaughan, York Region and Toronto including all Home Schools and Private Schools.
- C. No entry fee is required.
- D. Entry sizes are approximate and must not be larger than size specified.
- E. Please print all entry tags and make sure that the school entry number (school initials and 23 ex. Daystrom Public School is DPS23), section number and student's first name are clear. No last names should be used. Teacher's name or room number should be added to aid with the return of the school work. Entry Tags should be on the back of the work so that name is not visible when displayed.
- F. No work is to be mounted unless specified. All sizes are maximum allowed.
- G. The last date for entries is **Friday, September 29, 2023**. All entries are to be brought to the Woodbridge Fair Secretaries Office by appointment or picked up by David Maynard, **artwork can be picked up earlier in September and stored at the fairgrounds**. Email David at medicmaynard@sympatico.ca to arrange pick up.
- H. Prize ribbons will be given to the top 5 in each section. First Place Ribbon includes free entrance to the fair (no cash value). Schools will receive a fax or email listing first place prize winners.
- I. Prize winning exhibits will be displayed at the Woodbridge Fair, Thanksgiving Weekend October 7,8 and 9, 2023. They may be picked up by a teacher, parent or school representative on Monday, October 9 starting at 6:00 pm or artwork can be delivered on Tuesday, Oct 10, if arrangements are confirmed before the fair begins. Art work will be kept for only 3 days following the fair.
- J. We will display as much art as space allows. Art not selected to be displayed at the fair will be kept and returned with winning art following the fair.

CLASS OAAS3: JUNIOR includes youth up to & including Grade 4

Please Note: entries in this class can be made by the artist or by a school teacher on behalf of the artist.

- The hand drawn poster must clearly show the name and dates of the fair.
- The theme must be named.
- Poster Size: Minimum 22cm x 28cm without border / Maximum 28cm x 44cm without border
- Entries must be centered on cardstock or Bristol board exposing a 5.5 cm border on all four sides.
- Name of fair, district (#5), contact person, owner of poster to be clearly labeled on the back.
- The winning poster becomes the property of the Woodbridge Fair Board and may be used in the Fair's promotional advertising
- The winning poster will be eligible to enter the district competition. District winner will be eligible to enter at the provincial competition

Judging Standards:

- Overall Appearance – 50 points
 - Fair name, dates & theme clear
- Hand Drawn – 35 points
 - Attracts and holds attention
- OAAS Criteria – 15 points
 - Size, material, theme
