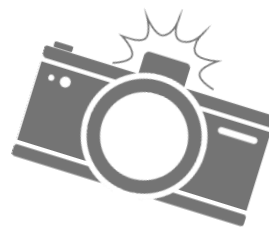

Tips on Showing:

1. Read the Prize List and follow the instructions carefully.
2. All entries must be the exclusive and personal work of the person submitting the entry.
3. This is a competition for amateur photographers and the work of professional photographers will not be accepted.
4. An entry fee of \$5.00 must be included with your entry. There is no entry fee needed for children entering Class 90A.
5. **PLEASE NOTE:** All entries must be at least 5" x 7" and no larger than 8" x 10", mounted on stiff cardboard with a 1" border all around with the name, address and phone number of the entrant written on the back. Please include the class and section in which it is to be entered.
6. Photographs must not have been entered in previous Woodbridge Fairs.
7. The same photograph cannot be entered in two categories.
8. **All entries must be received in the Secretary's Office no later than 3:00 pm on Wednesday, October 4.**
9. All entries must be picked up in person at the Burwick Community Building (#5) on Monday, October 9 no earlier than 6:00 pm. Photos not picked up will only be kept for 3 days following the fair.
10. Entry tags must be firmly attached to all articles by the exhibitor. Articles without tags or with tags improperly filled out will not be accepted.
11. The judge reserves the right not to show entries which they consider not suitable for family viewing.

All photographs will be judged as follows:

- ✓ 30 points for Quality of Photograph: focus, lighting, colour, angle of shot
- ✓ 30 points for Creativity: Placement of people or other subjects, use of colour and lighting, cropping
- ✓ 30 points for Subject Matter: is it representative of the section, impact, eye appeal to the viewer
- ✓ 10 points for Presentation: Overall look of the photograph including mounting
